

## Review Questions

1. **Which of Jacob's sons was Naphtali and who was his mother?** (The sixth son of Jacob and the second of Bilhah, Rachel's maid. Page 312)
2. **What does Jewish tradition say about Naphtali?** (That he was a swift runner and one of the five to represent the family before Pharaoh. Page 312)
3. **What animal was Naphtali compared to in Jacob's blessing?** (A hind let loose. Page 312)
4. **What is a hind and what traits does it have that would represent Naphtali's character?** (A female deer and it is very timid and ready to flee at the first approach of danger. No one would attempt to bind a burden on a deer. Page 312)
5. **What is the precious gift that Naphtali possesses?** (*"He giveth goodly words."* He has time to find those who are downcast and discouraged to encourage: the despondent and comfort the sorrowful. Page 313)
6. **What phrase in the Bible speaks of this tribe's courage in battle?** (*"They desolated their lives to death."* Judges 5:18. They were determined to conquer or die. They would plunge into the thickest of the battle if success depended on it. Page 313)
7. **What are the two attributes of the 12,000 that march under the banner of Naphtali?** (They will speak goodly words and, in difficult places, fearlessly stand firm at their post of duty, ready to sacrifice their lives rather than compromise the cause of God. Page 313)
8. **What blessing did Moses pronounce over Naphtali?** (*"O Naphtali, satisfied with favor, and full of blessing of the Lord."* Page 313)
9. **Why are we not "full with the blessing of the Lord?"** (Because we are not *"satisfied with favor."* Page 314)

10. **Who is the only great hero of Naphtali?** (Barak of Kadesh-Naphtali. Page 314)
11. **What is said about the battle fought by Barak?** (It was in many respects the greatest battle fought by the ancient people of God, and is a type, or object lesson, of the great battle of Armageddon. Page 314)
12. **What territory was given to Naphtali?** (The land on the west shore of the Sea of Galilee and extending northward. Page 314)
13. **Why was this territory the first to fall to the invading Syrians and Assyrians?** (It lay in their path and was a goodly land. Page 314)
14. **What did Isaiah say would happen in the territory of Zebulun and Naphtali?** (It would see a great light. Page 315)
15. **What was the fulfillment of this prophecy?** (Jesus, the “*Light of the world,*” would make his home by the Sea of Galilee in this territory. Page 315)
