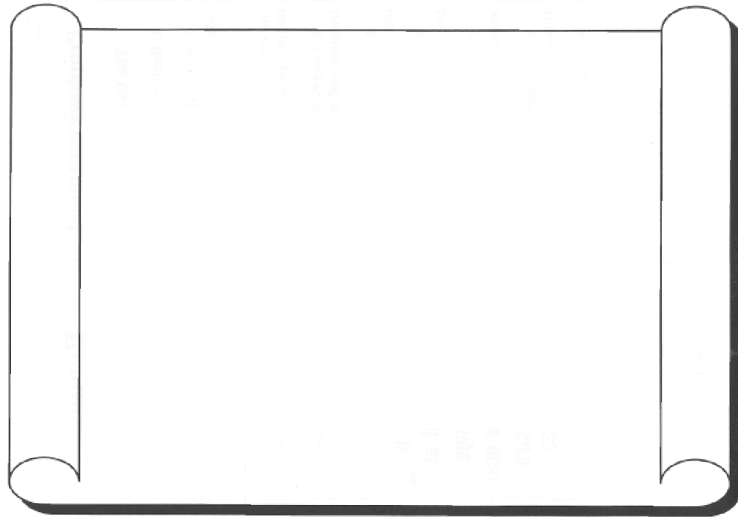

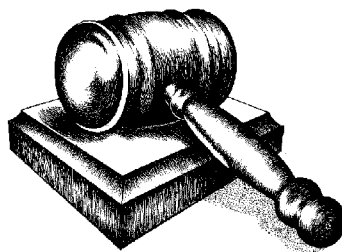

End of the 2300 Days



When the great clock of time struck the hour for the end of the 2300 days, the beginning of the antitypical tenth day of the seventh month, the Father, who up to this time had been seated with Christ in the holy place of the heavenly sanctuary, moved His throne into the holy of holies, preparatory to the beginning of the Judgment. See *Early Writings* pages 54-56.

The scene in the heavenly holy of holies at this time is, without doubt, one of the most awe-inspiring of any since the giving of the law at Sinai. Describing it, Daniel says: *“I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of Days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head like the pure wool: His throne was like the fiery flame, and His wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him: thousand thousands ministered unto Him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him: the Judgment was set, and the books were opened”* (Daniel 7:9-10).
