Our Agriculture expert Ps Missionary Maxwell has established the organic gardening project very well there. He now has travelled to Murehwa where he is busy doing the same work for that area!

We are grateful his skill and the program he developed has been seen as valuable by an agency that tries to use agriculture to help people to be more self-supporting. They now supply him with seeds, and travel to areas where he wishes to run his seminar. This is a help as we were struggling to support this wonderful program that is so welcomed by people and chiefs wherever he goes with it. And of course, Bible and spiritual ministry, as well as MMV health teaching are always a part of his seminars. It all goes together as the Lord instructed us. Our 2 Team 1 MMV girls are still working hard with Nurse Lynette and her girls, teaching sanitation, healthy lifestyle, better cooking and whole food diet to the people. Nurse Lynette struck up a friendship with a local nurse who is studying the Ministry of Healing, attending church, and very interested in the message. We pray she may become a full church member soon. May God bless our hard working MMV teams!

The Murehwa group.

As we said, Missionary Maxwell is now teaching his highly helpful Seminar in that area! The chief is so glad of this and all have welcomed him and are eagerly seeking to learn all they can. There are now actually two groups in that area and we hope the training will be able to be shared from the main group to the one at a distance. We encourage all people, whatever spiritual knowledge they are studying, to learn well enough so as to be teachers their own-selves. That is what Jesus tells us all to do! It is not His plan for anyone to sit and learn as some form of entertainment; instead as soon as we learn we are all to be prayerfully sharing with others, and we need not ask any human permission to obey the Lord's Great Commission for all who believe in Him!

We shared in last report, the area Chishawasha is a hotbed of supernatural challenges. The Pastors had to leave the area after only a week of meetings, which were highly attended with great interest, as it was locked down. There is deep poverty, spiritually and physically, in the area. Prayers are needed!
