Ngesi Agriculture Miracles:

Ps. Maxwell is at Ngesi continuing with Agriculture teaching for that village as this is planting time there. We are earnestly working to divert the people from growing tobacco for sale to the government, and instead growing healthy food crops to feed their families! We got what seeds we could and Ps Maxwell traveled with the seed company truck to accompany them. We were praying the Lord would multiply what we had and the first answer was the seed company donated a lot of needed seeds. We praised the Lord and kept praying. Then arrived some people from an independent development foundation and today they will be bringing a lot more seeds, enough for not only the 100 church families but the rest of the people as well, and made Ps Maxwell the one to be in charge! Our praises ascend to the Lord for His amazing grace. But still more good news came as we mentioned the needs of other of our groups, they voted to help us and plan to provide seeds for 2 more groups as soon as they have transportation for them. We are praying for this need to be met as planting season is short and they are needed now. Well this is amazing Ps Maxwell just reported this minute that the Foundation has allotted a huge donation of hundreds of kilos of assorted seeds to each of the 2 needy groups, to be delivered by truck mid December! They also fully accepted that we are giving them to our members mainly and they said it is all fine, just that we don't sell them or use for politics. We are arranging to rent trucks for the loads to get them sooner to the groups for planting! It is sure true that when the Lord answers prayers He does beyond anything we can imagine! See Ephesians 3:20. He Likes to surprise His little children! Folks, these miracles are happening as I write you this AM! Ps M. this minute said that they have just told him a third batch is going to be given to him today and the rest of it before end of week! They are so happy to help us because of our serving honestly the very poor, and the fact we are not political in any way! Ps Maxwell stated, "I don't know how to reply to our Great God. All I can say is, what a Mighty God we serve!"

Chishawasha Story:

We were contacted by the group leader there that they had another spirit worshipper who came forward to surrender to Jesus and asking help to destroy her devil charms. We prayed for them, and the church leaders, praying much, burned the stuff successfully. But head Elder T was taken ill, and being dizzy and sick he was helped to his home. As soon as we heard this report, Pastor T knew this was an occult attack and we joined prayers to seek the Lord earnestly for his restoration! Our prayers were answered right away!
